INTERNATIONAL PRE-SCHOOL AND PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS PROJECT "HAPPY EARTH 2026"

REGULATIONS

Earth Day is a meaningful opportunity to stop, look at the nature around us and develop a responsible, environmentally friendly attitude. Spring awakens life and invites children to discover the colorful, living world around them. By observing insects and beetles, children learn to understand their importance to nature, develop curiosity, responsibility and strengthen their connection with the environment.

I. GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. The regulations of the „Happy Earth 2026“ international pre-school and pre-primary educational institutions project, dedicated to the Earth Month, which continues from March 20 – the World Earth Day, to April 22, when the International Mother Earth Day is celebrated, (hereinafter referred to as the project) is created to regulate the purpose, tasks, participants and organization of the project.
2. The project is organized by Radviliskis district Baisogala school-kindergarten.

4. Regulations will be published:

4.1. On the website of the Radviliškis district Baisogala school-kindergarten <https://www.baisogalosmd.radviliskis.lm.lt> and Facebook account, complying with and ensuring data protection requirements.

II. PURPOSE AND TASKS

5. The goal is to develop ecological awareness among preschool and kindergarten children, encouraging them to learn about the world of insects and contribute practically to nature conservation by creating insect hotels on the occasion of Earth Day.

6. Project tasks:

6.1. to develop children's knowledge about insects and beetles, their lifestyle and importance to nature;

6.2. to observe and study insects and beetles living near the institution in order to better understand their species, behavior and needs;

6.3. to organize insect hotel production workshops in order to provide insects and beetles with a safe place to live;

6.4. develop cooperation between Lithuanian and foreign pre-school and pre-primary educational teachers, educational support specialists.

III. PARTICIPANTS OF THE PROJECT

7. Pupils with different abilities, teachers, educational support specialists from preschool and pre-primary educational institutions participate in the project and parents.

IV. EXECUTION OF THE PROJECT

8. Participants fill out the questionnaire (attachment No. 1) regarding participation in the project and send it by e-mail laimingazeme@gmail.com from **9 March 2026 until 24 April 2026**.

9. The number of participants from one institution is not limited.

10. Teachers and pupils discuss the meaning and importance of one of the most important and beautiful environmental celebration, World Earth Day, which is celebrated on March 20. The flag of the Earth

is raised, which reminds us of everyone's responsibility for the Earth. From this day, Earth Month begins, during which children, with the help of teachers, are encouraged to donate their most beautiful arts to our Earth.

11. We invite participants who joined the project to implement all three stages of the project:

11.1. Stage I – Educational activities

Cognitive activities about insects and beetles are organized, including conversations, reading fairy tales and informational books, viewing visual materials, and creative and artistic activities. Children are introduced to the diversity of insects, their living conditions, and their benefits to nature.

11.2. Stage II – Observations in nature

Children are invited to observe insects in outdoor environments—such as the kindergarten yard, a park, or other natural areas. Observations are carried out, findings are recorded, insect behavior is discussed, and a respectful and safe relationship with living nature is encouraged.

11.3. Stage III – Making an insect hotel

Together with teachers and parents, children make an insect hotel using natural and recycled materials. This activity encourages creativity and teamwork and allows children to practically contribute to improving insects' living conditions, reinforcing a responsible attitude toward the environment.

12. The project ends on April 22, memorizing International Mother Earth Day.

13. All project activities are photographed, and photos or a collage of photos with information about the participant (country, institution name, child's first and last name or group name, teacher/educational support specialist's first and last name) are placed in the closed **Facebook group „Laiminga Žemė“** <https://www.facebook.com/groups/697499535801077/> until April 24.

14. High-quality photos, where children's faces will not be visible, will be selected for the project.

V. FINAL REGULATIONS

15. Pupils, who participated in the project, will receive letters of participation from the Baisogala school-kindergarten. Baisogala school-kindergarten certificates will be prepared for the teachers and educational support specialists. Letters for participation and certificates will be posted in the closed Facebook group "Laiminga Žemė" until April 30.
16. By submitting a photo or photo collage to the project, the participant confirms that he is the author of this photo. The submitter is responsible for copyright infringements. Participation in the project corresponds to the authors' acceptance of these terms.
